

Course Title: Bachelor in Prosthetics and Orthotics-4 ½ years

Q1. What is the minimum admission requirements?

- i) Candidate who has passed the two year Pre-University examination conducted by Department of Pre-University Education, Karnataka State or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with English as one of the language and physics, chemistry and mathematics/biology as optional subjects with not less than **50%** of marks in the aggregate of the relevant science subjects i.e., Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics provided the candidate has passed in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics subjects individually to be eligible for admission to this course.

Note: The case of students belonging to SC/ ST and Category I, the marks obtained in physics, chemistry and mathematics/biology together in qualifying examination is not less than **45%** instead of 50% as above for admission to this course.

- ii) Candidates who have passed Diploma in Prosthetics & Orthotics approved by Rehabilitation Council of India shall also be eligible for this program and shall be admitted directly to III year BPO course year, provided they have passed 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Mathematics as optional subjects. Admissions will be on the availability of the seats in 3rd year.

Q.2: What is the duration of the program?

- 4 years and 6 months (Full time)

Q.3: What is the admission process?

Step 1: Online eligibility certificate has to be obtained from Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka through **www.ecms.online** by paying eligibility fees using card or internet banking.

Step 2: After acquiring eligibility certificate, send the fully filled in application along with relevant documents and online eligibility certificate. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS ARE NOT ENTERTAINED.**

Step 3: Entrance examination will be conducted at the school for respective candidates.

Step 3: Counselling or verbal interview with candidates.

Step 4: Successful candidates will receive the admission letter from the school

Step 5: Remit the fees

Step 6: Send the travel plan

Step 7: Receive the campus rules and declaration forms from school. It should be read and signed by applicant, parents, and parent's organisation/sponsor.

Step 8: Bring **ORIGINAL COPY** OF mark sheet, certificates and other documents for submission at school.

Note:

Applicants are advised to report to Mobility India at least one day prior to the commencement of classes and meet the Manager-Academic Administration to complete the admission formalities. It would also help candidates in settling down in the environment.

Q.4: When admission starts and ends?

- Admission starts: 1st April and Admission ends: 30th August

Q.5: When session starts?

- 1st week of October

Q.6: Does student get vacation during the study?

- Vacation: 30 days' vacation will be followed after the yearly examination in the month of September

Q.7: Does student get leaves during the study?

- Student has to maintain the 80% of attendance to become eligible for the final examination.

Q.8: What are the documents to be attached with filed in application form?

2. Photocopy of 10 years of schooling certificate and mark sheet attested by competent authorities/government notary/government gazetted officer - 2 nos.
3. Photocopy of 12 years of schooling certificate and mark sheet attested by competent authorities/government notary/government gazetted officer - 2 nos.
4. Photocopy of Transfer Certificate attested by competent authorities/government notary/government gazetted officer - 2 nos.
5. Photocopy of Migration Certificate attested by competent authorities/government notary/government gazetted officer - 2 nos.
6. Online eligibility certificate of Rajiv Gandhi university of Health Sciences.
7. Photocopy of Character certificate from School/college.
8. Physical fitness certificate from Government Hospital Doctor
9. Sponsorship certificate from the sponsor outlining what costs they will cover and confirming they will fund the entire course (If applicable)
10. Recommendation letter from organisation (present/past employer) (If applicable)
11. LABORATORY TESTS- Blood- Ag HBs (Hepatitis B), Ac HCv (Hepatitis C), Tuberculin Skin test (Mantoux) and Complete blood count by Government Hospital doctor
