However, he is diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) which is a genetic disease affecting the part of the nervous system that controls voluntary muscle movement. Due to this, his physical condition has been affected severely, he is unable to walk and stand. He visited MI in 2011 for the first time and went through complete assessment- he was provided with bilateral Ankle-Foot Orthosis and Knee gaiters to support his mobility.

Recently, he visited Mobility India for the wheelchair support to increase his mobility. Danish says, 'With wheelchair I can go to school regularly and focus on my studies'. Danish is a boy full of dreams and hope, his mother continuous support and encouragement keeps his determination going even when things are tough.
