

Sensitization Programme

On October 17, 2019 an awareness programme was conducted for Asha and Anganwadi Workers on Visual and Hearing Impairment and its Assistive Devices and Daily Living Activities at Chamrajnagar. Team oriented on early identification, causes, types, treatment and aftercare for visual and hearing impairment. 32 members participated.

As a result, Asha and Anganwadi member shared, the training programmes are helping them in identifying the children with hearing and visual impairment and referring them for treatment and preventive actions.



Awareness programme for Parents of Children with Cerebral Palsy

On October 18, 2019 at Maleyuru Therapy Centre Mobility India Chamrajnagar team organised an awareness camp for parents of children with cerebral palsy. Information on the causes, to prevent further deformities through the usage of appropriate devices and management of children with Cerebral Palsy was provided. 20 parents participated.

Parents shared that through the information provided they are now seeing improvement in their children also the preventive action during pregnancy is being taken care of in their community.



Assessment Programme for Locomotor Disability

An assessment programme was carried out for children with locomotor disability on October 11, 2019 at Chamrajnagar office. Under this programme, children with Cerebral Palsy and other neurological programme were assessed and prescribed with appropriate assistive devices. 17 users availed the services.



General Health Screening

On October 22, 2019 a General Health Screening was conducted for persons with disabilities at Topatoli Gram Panchayat and Topatoli Village Panchayat in collaboration with SHARP NGO. 52 persons with disabilities were screened for general health ailments.
