Five years Anam Zohar lives with her mother at her maternal uncle's house at Yarabnagar, Karnataka. Anam's mother goes for domestic work and earns meagre amount in order to contribute towards their living expenses. When Anam was 2 years old, mother observed her inability to respond to any of her promptings which she perceived to be hearing problems. Due to financial constraints she could not afford any medical intervention.

Recently she was identified by SHG members in her community and referred to MI for possible support. From MI she was referred for a medical consultation and ENT Doctor suggested her to use hearing aid. Financial constraints still stood as barrier. She now has a hearing aid which improved her hearing. She is able to respond and communicate with others with ease. Currently she is enrolled in LKG and is very regular at school. She loves mingling and playing with peer students.
