

National Conference on Assistive Technology for All-AT 2030

The first ever National Conference on Assistive Technology for All-AT 2030 was held on 2nd and 3rd August 2019 at NIMHANS Convention Centre, Bengaluru. The conference was conceived by Mobility India on the occasion of 25th anniversary in the disability sector. The theme of the conference was" Improving access to quality and affordable assistive technology". The AT conference was aimed to bring together various stakeholders in public, private and voluntary sectors to help identify the best innovations/solutions available to help scale-up and make AT available to all.


